## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: (I) Additional 2% rates for MEIS and SEIS beyond 31.03.2019.

(II) Withdrawal of MEIS on export of garments and made-ups after implementation of RoSCTL scheme w.e.f. 07.03.2019.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the meeting dated 10.6.2019 held by Revenue Secretary regarding the subject issues. DGFT's OM F. No. 01/61/180/369/AM19/PC-3 dated 12.6.2019 also refers. In this context, Record of Discussion of the aforesaid meeting dated 10.06.2019 is enclosed herewith.

- 2. In view of the foregoing, it is requested that additional 2% MEIS and SEIS rates which were enhanced in Nov/Dec. 2017 may be withdrawn with effect from 01.08.2019.
- 3. In view of para 3.1 of the Record of Discussion, it is requested that financial allocation may be sought for FY 2019-20 for MEIS/SEIS schemes.
- 4. Further, it is requested to withdraw the MEIS benefits on export of garments and made-ups (Chapters 61, 62 and 63 of ITC-HS) with effect from 01.08.2019.
